Massachusetts regulations explicitly require schools to educate their school personnel about the laws governing reporting child abuse and neglect and physically restraining students. Thus, districts must conduct training on these regulations and provide documentation of training to the Department of Education through the Coordinated Program Review (CPR).

This workshop will provide administrators and other persons responsible for implementation of these laws with the information that school personnel need to know, including “Mandated Reporter” requirements and procedures and implementation of restraint protocols. This workshop also will cover the district’s responsibilities to educate staff about conducting CORI reviews required of all employees and volunteers. The presenter will provide copies of overheads and handouts so that attendees can use these same materials to provide training to school district personnel on these topics.
